- b) The Fall ride took place on October 1<sup>st</sup>. It was a little drizzly but it was a fun day. We met at the snow gauge and Jimmer Dube led us to Gay and Lac la Belle where we ate lunch. There were over 20 machines on the ride.

### New Business:

- a) ATV Illustrated magazine had an article that paid recognition to the Keweenaw ATV Club and all our hard work.
- b) Kitty has secured a \$15,000 grant for the ATV Club. Thank you Kitty for applying for these grants on our behalf.
- c) The Lac la Belle trail needs to have steel posts and signs put up along the road side from the mailboxes to the start of the trail. Once the trail is signed, we can ask for it to be approved as a designated KATV Trail.
- d) other notes- \*The Vansville parking lot will be closed until further notice. The bar is under new ownership and is going under renovations. The cash on display, \$1592.00, from the bar was removed and donated to the Keweenaw Snowmobile Club. \*The Hubbell VFW is selling memorial pavers for \$50. The memorial will be constructed across from the VFW next to the Firehall.
